



## Camp Lutherhaven's 60th Anniversary Celebration

Can you believe Camp Lutherhaven will be celebrating 60 years in 2009? That's right - 1949-2009.

Mark your calendar! Many of you were at Camp ten (yes, 10!) years ago as Camp celebrated a "Fifty Year Trail of Faith", the 50th anniversary of Camp Lutherhaven. Amazingly, another decade has passed, with literally thousands of lives touched by outdoor ministry in the heart of God's creation. Accordingly, Lutherhaven is planning to commemorate this milestone on Sunday, August 2, 2009 with an exciting, extended day of activities, including the Annual Chicken Dinner.

The theme for the event is "Honoring the Past; Looking to the Future", with the focus being on reconnecting people with each other, and with Camp Lutherhaven. The day will include a special worship service with speaker Rev. Ken Klaus, speaker of The Lutheran Hour, dedication of the new Treetop Village, visiting with past summer staff who will be there for an alumni reunion, and the traditional Chicken

Dinner. In the afternoon there will be a video presentation, a "memory lane" full of photo albums, scrapbooks and other memorabilia to peruse, time for attendees to share their Camp memories, and more.

Proceeds from this event will go towards Camp Lutherhaven's current special project which is to replace the swimming U-dock that goes into Lake Muncie. The current dock has served extremely well over the last 30+ years. However, between resurfacing every few years, keeping a safe swimming environment, and the annual repairs needed, a new dock makes for good stewardship. The financial goal is \$12,000.

It will certainly be a day of celebration of what God has done - and is doing through this unique ministry. The dinner will include chicken, rolls, vegetables, drinks, and dessert. Adult servings will be sold for \$7.00 and child servings will be sold for \$5.00 at the door.

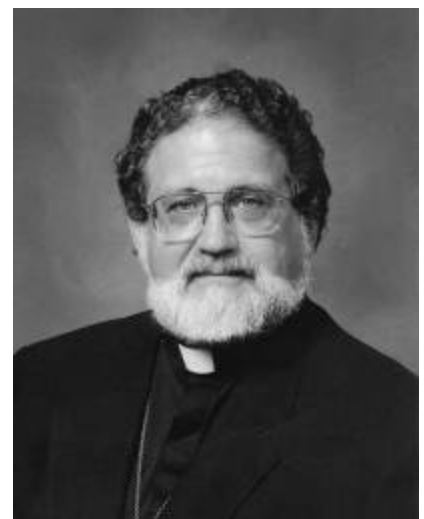
