Registration will begin at 7:00 p.m. on Friday, May 28, in the Lodge. Our opening and orientation will begin at 7:30 p.m. The weekend officially will end on Monday after lunch. This weekend is free because your time, effort, and work are priceless to Camp Lutherhaven!

**Community Policy** One of the awesome things about summer camp at Camp Lutherhaven is the opportunity to experience a special Christian community in the midst of God's creation. In order to achieve this goal, it is expected that participants come with an attitude of cooperation, goodwill, and respect for people and God's creation. 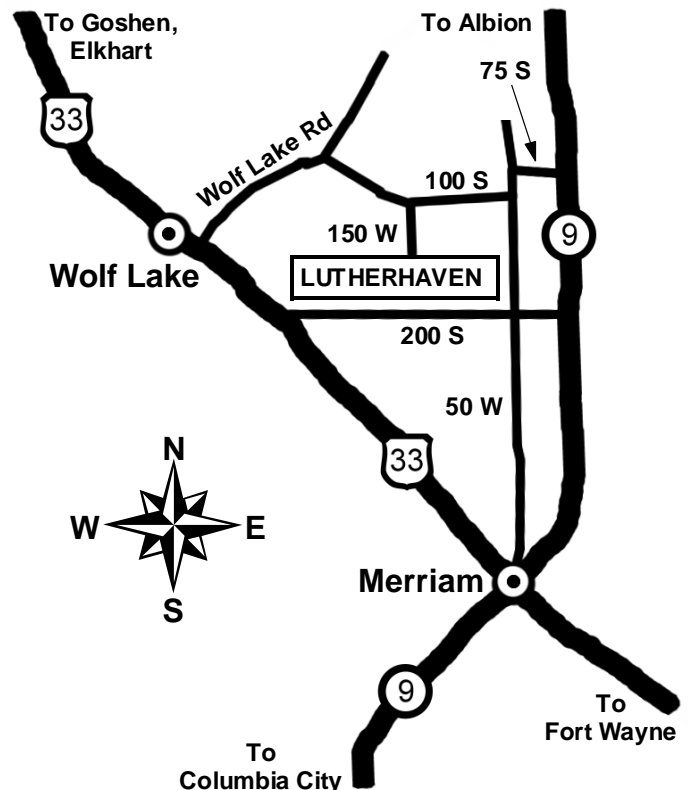
### Saturday/Sunday/Monday A.M.
