**Registration** will take place in the PAVILION (near the parking lot) from 9:00 to 9:30am, Tuesday morning.

In order to make registration a speedy, pleasant process, we are asking care providers, parents, or guardians to:

- 1 Complete registration between 9:00 and 9:30 a.m. If you are unable to be at Camp during this time, please notify the office as soon as possible to make special arrangements.
- 2 Have your checks dated and written out to *Camp Lutherhaven* beforehand or bring the exact amount you owe in cash. This year you may include any *camper bank deposits* (see below) on the same check as your registration balance. -- **Or to make your registration process even faster**, make your registration payment to Lutherhaven at least two weeks ahead of time.
- 3 Have the camper's medical forms completed, including signatures if you haven't sent it in already. Also make sure to have all medications clearly labeled.
- 4 Make sure to check out Lutherhaven's t-shirts and sweatshirts if you're so inclined. Registration and pick-up times work well for this. Shirts and sweatshirts range in price from \$8 to \$35.

**Camper Banks** are provided to care for the camper's spending money while at camp. Money is deposited at registration and is available to the campers at the canteen on a paperless, credit basis. Campers will not need to handle any money and will be informed of their remaining balance during each canteen time. Use of the camper bank is optional but encouraged. Campers can purchase items at the canteen two times each day. We suggest \$2 – \$3 per day for spending money for canteen. Add more if the camper is interested in purchasing a hat, t-shirt, or sweatshirt. Shirts and sweatshirts range in price from \$8 to \$35. Leftover money will be returned to the care provider, parent, or guardian on the last day of camp. The amount you are depositing can be included in your registration payment.

**Community Policy** One of the awesome things about summer camp at Camp Lutherhaven is the opportunity to experience a special Christian community in the midst of God's creation. In order to achieve this goal, it is expected that participants come with an attitude of cooperation, goodwill, and respect for people and God's creation. Please consider carefully your language, dress, and behavior. Cursing, inappropriate or revealing clothing, and disrespectful or harmful behavior will not be tolerated. In addition, items such as cell phones can become disruptive and a distraction to the present formation of Camp community, relationships, and interaction with Creation around them. Because of this, cell phones are prohibited for those 18 years and under. Camp Lutherhaven reserves the right to send a camper home that is unable to function within this guideline.

**Refunds** Your \$15 deposit is non-refundable except for instances of death/illness/injury in the family.

**Lost & Found** Every year we accumulate hundreds of lost and found items. Consider labeling all important articles (Bibles, cameras, towels, sleeping bags) that are being brought to Camp. After camp, contact us if you are missing something.

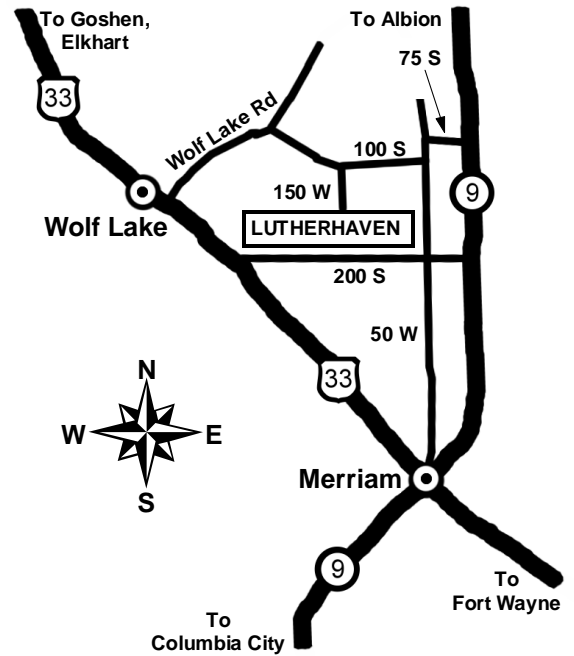
